1. Curling

- Please check the attached sheet to confirm your start times.
- Be ready to go out on the ice about 10 minutes before your start time.
- Flip a coin for last rock.
- Games are a maximum of 1 hour - to stay on schedule. To help move the game along, be sure you are ready to deliver your rock as soon as the opposition rock has stopped.
- No sweeping between hog lines. The player in the house may sweep once a rock is over the hog line.
- Check to see what colour your team plays.
- Ron Gill is the official draw master and will post the results of your game on the draw sheet - so please tell him who won your game.

Shoes

For those who haven't been to the club recently, we have implemented a "No Outdoor Shoe Policy" within the club. Please bring some indoor shoes and leave your outdoor shoes on the shelves provided at the entrance of the club.

For those who do not have **curling shoes**, shoes worn out on the ice must be totally clean & free of dirt, salt & sand.

Championship Finals

All winners of the Main Event in each pool will participate in a 'Draw to the Button' contest at ~6:30 PM on Saturday.

- Pool winners should be ready to go on the ice at 6:30 pm (except those in Pool E who will still be curling).
 - Pool A and B winners will go to Ice #1
 - C and D winners will go to Ice #2
 - E winner will use Ice #3
- Both players on each winning team will throw a practice rock to the house at the far end (no broom).
- Each player will then take turns, alternating with the other team and throw a rock towards the glass. Each rock will be scored to determine the overall winning team.
 - **Scoring:** Covering the pin - 6 pts., Button - 5 pts., 4' - 4 pts., 8' - 3 pts., 12' - 2 pts. and in play but not in the house - 1 pt.
- The team with the highest point score will be declared the 2019 Parry Sound Curlers Care Champion
- All other pool winners will be ranked based on their total team scores.

2. PLEDGES:

- Be sure that the Name, Address and Postal Code are legible and complete for each donor. All pledges of \$20 or more will receive Income tax receipts from the North Bay MFRC.
